No separate meeting of Chairs and Vice Chairs will be held; however, Chairs and Vice Chairs are welcome at the judges meetings.

Lead Judges will provide the Judges Tally Sheets to the Judges Chair (or turn in to Registration) by 8:00 am on Tuesday (Sessions 1 – 16), by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday (Sessions 17 – 24) and by 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday (Sessions 25 – 32). A Lead Judge for each session has already been assigned and is designated on the judges list for each session. The Lead Judge is responsible for ensuring that a decision is reached, documented, and communicated back to the Judges Chair. The Best in Session Awards will be presented at the dinner on Tuesday evening.

Please make a special effort to visit the posters of each student that presented during the session you are judging.
