### **Judging Criteria – Undergraduate Program Participants**

- 1. Research knowledge (10 points max.)**
  - a. Demonstrated knowledge/understanding of the information presented
  - b. Demonstrated knowledge/understanding of the research problem
  - c. Ability to explain research techniques used, how data were gathered & analyzed
  - d. Ability to propose appropriate future research/next steps
- 2. Technical content & student contribution (10 points max.)**
  - a. Difficulty of the project from a science, engineering, or mathematical perspective
  - b. Degree to which the research presented represents the work of the student
- 3. Presentation (includes verbal presentation & visual poster) (10 points max.)**
  - a. Organization of presentation—logical flow of information
  - b. Graphical representation of data
  - c. Visual appearance—readability of text & graphics
  - d. Ability to communicate orally about the research in a clear and succinct manner
  - e. Professional delivery of material

**Note: Professional dress is strongly encouraged during poster presentations.**
