



Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program

Use of data

Information about participants in the Undergraduate Research Opportunities (URO) program managed by SRC Education Alliance (SRCEA) is collected in order to measure the program's longitudinal and attitudinal impact on its participants and to determine if the program is meeting its goals and objectives.

Data is reported **in aggregate** to Intel Foundation and SRC Education Alliance's current and future stakeholders in order to garner financial support for the continuation and growth of the program.

Personally identifiable information is not shared without the student's written consent.

Upon URO program entry, students complete the "New Student Information" form via the password protected SRC web site whereby they provide consent, which is totally voluntary.

Upon URO program exit, students are asked by the Program Manager to complete and return via email the "Completed Student Information" form (not yet available via the SRC web site). If the student does not complete the form, the URO Program Managers are asked to provide the following information about the exited students:

- Date of Exit
- Cumulative GPA at Exit
- New mailing address
- New email
- Reason for Exit:
 - Quit Program (Y/N)
 - Transferred Universities (Y/N)
 - Changed Majors (Y/N)
 - List New Major
 - Other (Please explain)
 - Graduated (Y/N)
 - Graduate School (Name of University)
 - Graduate degree/discipline
 - Employed (Y/N)
 - Employer
